**Q80011401 - I am booting Mountain Lion 10.8.5 from a RAID 0 volume on Areca RAID adapter. I upgrade to Mavericks (10.9) and run the installer and the system reboots, the installation hangs at the startup screen and I have to manually reselect Mountain Lion as my startup volume.**

Apple stopped selling operating system DVDs in its stores or recovery disks with new

Macs, and switched to downloadable installers for OS X upgrades. OS X 10.9 can not

upgrade the RAID adapter bootable volume from the OS X installer package. You need

to use the DiskMaker X to build a bootable USB key from the OS X 10.9 installer package.
